POZVANI PREDAVAČI / INVITED LECTURES



Jill Maddison (UK)

Jill is Professor of General Practice and responsible for the RVC's Continuing Professional Development (CPD) programme including management of the RCVS Certificate of Advanced Veterinary Practice. She is also Director of Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine (BVetMed) course and chair of the RVC's Equality and Diversity Committee. She contributes to the RVC's teaching programme for veterinary students and veterinary nurses in the areas of small animal medicine, clinical reasoning and clinical pharmacology.

Jill is a graduate of the University of Sydney. She completed an internship at the University of Sydney, spent 18 months in full time private practice in Sydney then completed a residency in small animal medicine at the University of Guelph, Canada. She returned to Australia and completed a PhD entitled Neurochemistry of Hepatic Encephalopathy at The University of Sydney. She was a senior tutor and clinician in the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences at the University of Sydney from 1987 and from 1990-2000 was a senior lecturer in the Department of Pharmacology. During this time she also worked in general and specialist veterinary practice and was a consultant for a veterinary clinical pathology lab. In 2000 she became the Director of the Veterinary Science Foundation at the University of Sydney.

From 2002 she was a veterinary clinician and lecturer at the Royal Veterinary College, London based at the college's first opinion practice and was appointed a Fellow at Girton College, Cambridge where she tutored in pharmacology. She is currently Professor of General Practice, Director of Professional Development and Director of the BVetMed course at the Royal Veterinary College (RVC). She is actively involved in undergraduate teaching and CPD at the RVC in the areas of small animal medicine, clinical problem solving and clinical pharmacology.

Jill has published over 60 refereed papers in veterinary and medical journals and is the senior editor of Small Animal Clinical Pharmacology, the 2nd edition of which was published by Elsevier in 2008. She is also senior editor of Clinical Reasoning in Small Animal Practice published by Wiley-Blackwell in March 2015. She has lectured extensively around the world on clinical problem solving, small animal internal medicine and clinical pharmacology. Jill was co-chair of the Scientific Program Committee for the World Small Animal Veterinary Association Congress held in Sydney in 2007 and is the coordinator of the small animal main clinical CPD streams at The London Vet Show. She is also the regional coordinator for South East Asia on the World Small Animal Veterinary Association Continuing Education Committee. To keep in touch with the realities of private general practice she consults at a local veterinary practice and at the RVC's first opinion practice, the Beaumont Sainsbury Animal Hospital.



David Church (UK)

David is Deputy Principal and acting Vice Principal Clinical Affairs at the Royal Veterinary College. He is an internationally recognised specialist in disorders of the endocrine system in dogs and cats. David's current research interests include the underlying mechanism for the development and resolution of diabetes mellitus and the use of clinical data collected from general veterinary practices to enhance understanding and consequently improve both the health and welfare of animals and translational medicine opportunities.

David obtained his veterinary degree from The University of Sydney and after graduation and a short spell in practice he was appointed as a small animal clinical instructor at The University of Sydney and then enrolled in a PhD programme in the Faculty of Medicine looking at various aspects of the pathophysiology of diabetes mellitus.

After completing his PhD, David was appointed as a member of faculty in small animal medicine at The University of Sydney rising to become Hospital Director of The University Veterinary Centre.

In 2001 David was appointed Chair of Small Animal Studies at the Royal Veterinary College and head of the newly formed Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences. Over the next 8 years the department grew to be one of the largest and most successful clinical departments in the world with substantial research grant funding and an outstanding reputation for clinical excellence.

David is currently Deputy Principal and Acting Vice Principal Clinical Affairs. Despite his heavy administrative load, David maintains a keen interest in small animal medicine generally and endocrinology in particular. His current research interests include insulin resistance states in diabetes mellitus and the use of 'big data' from general practice for managing animal health and welfare.

David is the author of over 150 scientific articles, numerous book chapters, is joint editor of the highly successful textbook "Small Animal Clinical Pharmacology" now in its second edition and the soon to be released textbook entitled "Logical Approach to Clinical Problem Solving."

He has had an ongoing interest in relevant continuing education for practitioners and in particular the value of the problem-oriented approach to small animal medicine.



Michael Farrell (UK)

Mike Farrell graduated from the Royal Veterinary College in 1997 and completed internships at Bristol and Edinburgh Universities. He's worked in the UK and Australia as a general practitioner and in the USA and Switzerland as a veterinary anaesthetist. Mike completed a surgery residency at Glasgow University in 2006 and gained his European Diploma in Small Animal Surgery in 2007. He's an EBVS and RCVS board certified specialist in small animal surgery.



Vladimír Jekl (CZ)

Associate Professor, MVDr., Ph.D., Dip. ECZM (Small Mammal)
European Recognised Specialist in Zoological Medicine (Small Mammal)

Vladimír Jekl is a 2002 graduate of the University of Veterinary and Pharmaceutical Sciences (VETUNI Brno) Brno, Czech Republic. He obtained his Ph.D. in exotic companion mammal dentistry in 2006. He has practiced exclusively exotic animal medicine and since 2009 is European Recognised Specialist in Zoological Medicine (Small Mammal Medicine and Surgery) from 2016 he obtains the title of Associate Professor at the VETUNI Brno, now working at the Department of Pharmacology and Pharmacy. Since 2017 he is the co-owner of the Jekl & Hauptman Veterinary Clinic - Focused on Exotic Companion Mammals, the clinic exclusively takes care of exotic companion mammals. He has lectured extensively in Europe and partially also in the USA and he has published more than 400 articles in regional and international journals and books, including chapters in BSAVA Manuals; Ferrets, Rabbits, and Rodents Clinical Medicine and Surgery, 4th ed.; Practical Veterinary Dental Radiography; BSAVA Manual of Rodents and ferrets; BSAVA Manual of Rabbit Surgery, Dentistry and Imaging and he is the editor of VCNA Exotic Animal Practice issues - Respiratory Medicine and Reproductive Medicine. He is a major tutor for the EVDS course for Small Mammal Dentistry. His current focus involves dental disease, internal medicine, diagnostic imaging, and soft tissue surgery in



Anđelko Gašpar (HR)

Dr. med. vet., diplomirao na Veterinarskom fakultetu sveučilišta u Zagrebu (1989.), završio poslijediplomski studij iz područja biomedicine i zdravstva, znanstveno polje Veterinarska medicina, smjer Fiziologija i patologija goveda s umjetnim osjemenjivanjem (1999.) te obranio doktorat iz područja biomedicine i zdravstva, znanstveno polje Veterinarska medicina (2008.). Član je Hrvatske veterinarske komore, Hrvatskog mikrobiološkog društva I Viteškog alkarskog društva. Nositelj Spomenice domovinskog rata i Spomenice domovinske zahvalnosti. Kao djelatnik Ministarstva poljoprivrede bio je nositelj izrade nacionalnog Programa suzbijanja trihineloze u republici Hrvatskoj, kojeg je 1998. godine donijela Vlada Republike Hrvatske, a temeljem kojeg su se u petogodišnjem razdoblju provodile mjere suzbijanja i iskorjenjivanja trihineloze. Bio je i član pregovaračkog tima za pregovore s EU, u poglavlju 12. Veterinarstvo, sigurnost hrane i fitosanitarna politika.



Maja Šeparović Lisak, dr. med., (HR)

Dr. med., specijalist psihijatar, s užom specijalizacijom iz biologijske psihijatrije i psihoterapijskom edukacijom iz Transakcijske Analize (TA). Kao specijalist Zavoda za personologiju, poremećaje ličnosti i hranjenja ima dugogodišnje iskustvo u razumijevanju ličnosti i ponašanja, kao i u individualnom i grupnom psihoterapijskom radu. Sudionik je različitih edukativnih programa i projekata, te autor niza stručnih radova i poglavlja u stručnim knjigama: "Poremećaji hranjenja - od razumijevanja do liječenja", "Psihoanalitički modeli komunikacije u vremenu brzih promjena", "Nelagoda u kulturi 21. stoljeća", "Psihodinamika ljubavi i mržnje".
